DAY 1 Depart USA

Today you will board your overnight flight from USA bound for bella Italia. Enjoy an In-flight meal and entertainment.

DAY 2 Arrive in Rome Italy

Today you arrive into Rome Airport in Italy. You will be met by our local representative and transferred to your hotel in **Lido di Ostia**, 10 minutes away. DAY 3 Fly South to Sicily

Highlights of our tour include the **Duomo**, the **Palace of the Normans and the Church of St. John of the Hermits.** You will visit the magnificent **Benedictine Cloister** in **Monreale** which

was a part of a **Benedictine Abbey**. After your tour you will board you coach and make your way to your hotel where you will spend the next 3 nights. Tonight, you will enjoy your welcome dinner, a 3-course meal at a local restaurant within walking distance of the hotel.

DAY 4 Palermo

After breakfast this morning you will board your private coach ahead of your next adventure. Today you will visit the breathtaking **Palazzo dei Normanni & Cappella Palatina**, the Royal Palace and Palatine Chapel. These are part of the Arab-Norman Palermo and the Cathedrals of Cefalu and Monreale



UNESCO World Heritage Site. The stunning Chapel is a mix of Byzantine, Islamic and Latin elements and it is decorated with the most wonderful Byzantine mosaics. Following this you will visit the **Cathedral of Palermo,** one of the most important architectural monuments in Sicily. It truly is a treasure of the Norman architecture in Sicily. The rest of the afternoon you will be free to do some shopping or simply relax. This evening dinner will be on own.

DAY 5 Cefalu

Enjoy a light breakfast at the hotel as today you will venture 50 miles east to the **medieval town of Cefalu** know worldwide for the narrow streets and buildings with elaborate architectural decoration. You will be met by a tour guide you will give you a 2-hour tour of Cefalu. You will visit the **Cefalu Cathedral** (**Duomo**), which features the magnificent mosaics and the fisherman's quarter makes for Kodak moments. You will enjoy a seafood lunch at a local restaurant and there will be time for independent wandering before returning to Palermo where you will have the rest of the day to yourself. Dinner on own.

DAY 6 Trapani & Marsala

Bid farewell to Palermo and begin your journey to **Agrigento**, one of the oldest Sicilian cities rich in history where bustling modern city meets sprawling ancient ruins. You will stop along the way in **Trapani and visit Museo del Sale**, the Trapani Windmills which is still home to some of the windmills once used to drain water from the basins (containing ponds). Drawing salt from water remains a slow process, similar to desalination. You will make another stop in the **Marsala region** for a **wine cellar tour and tasting** before getting back on the road to Agrigento. Once you have arrived and



checked into your hotel, you will have some time to freshen up ahead of your 3-course group dinner.

DAY 7 Valley of the Temples



Today after breakfast you will board your private coach with a local guide for a half-day tour of **Agrigento & Valley of the Temples.** The Valley of the Temples is undoubtedly the most important vestige of ancient classical culture in Sicily. It lies in the rocky ridge bordering the plateau to the south on which ancient Akragas once stood. You will visit the **Valley of the Temples Museum** before a free afternoon of leisure. Dinner is own tonight.

DAY 8 Syracuse

Today after breakfast, our journey will take us **exploring Southern Sicily**. You will stop in **Syracuse** on your way to your destination **Taormina**. Syracuse is known for the cultural and artistic heritage of the Greeks, a city over 2700 years old. A local guide will meet you upon arrival in Syracuse and take you on a half day tour. You will visit **the Archaeological Park Neapolis** one of the most visited archaeological



sites in Syracuse where it's possible to see the most important remains of the ancient Greek and Roman town. Continue your journey to Catania where you will spend your final 3 nights. Tonight dinner is on own.

DAY 9 Mt. Etna



This morning enjoy breakfast at the hotel, before you depart on an adventure up mighty **Mt. Etna**, the highest and largest active volcano in Europe. Your tour will allow you to see the opening of the lava flow, visiting the eruptions that have occurred in the last years. The elevation is about 10,000 feet! You will take **a Mt. Etna winery tour and tasting** including a 3-course lunch. You will conclude the day back in Catania a multicolored universe, from the glittering whiteness of it's Baroque stuccoes to the lava black of the Liotru, the elephant sculpted from basalt that greets us in Piazza Duomo in the heart of the city. This

evening dinner is on own.

DAY 10 Taormina & Ancient Amphitheater of Taormina

After breakfast this morning you will set out and explore the beautiful hilltop town **Taormina**, perched on a rocky headland high above the sea. A local guide will meet you and take you on a 2-hour walking tour of Taormina. One of the highlights includes a visit to the **Ancient Amphitheater of Taormina** the most fascinating historical monument in the pearl of the Ionian Sea. It was born to accommodate dramatic performances or musical, it was transformed during Roman times to make rooms for games and gladiatorial battles. The remainder of your final day is at



your own leisure. Tonight meet the group at a local restaurant for the farewell dinner.
