Sunday November 23rd: Heading for the Emerald Isle

Today you start your journey by departing the United States and taking an overnight flight across the Atlantic Ocean to arrive in Dublin Airport, Ireland.

Monday November 24th: Welcome to Ireland

This morning, you will arrive at Dublin Airport. Once you proceed through to the arrivals area, you will be met and transferred to your first destination—Dublin, the small capital of Ireland with a big reputation. We will take a panoramic sightseeing tour of Dublin, taking in local landmarks and historic buildings such as the GPO (General Post Office) on O'Connell Street and Trinity College, home to the famous Book of Kells, among many others.





Next, you'll delve into the heart of one of Ireland's most iconic brands—Guinness. Since 1759, the legendary St. James's Gate Brewery has been its home. We'll visit the **Guinness Storehouse** to explore the story behind this world-renowned drink. The seven floors of the Storehouse bring to life the heritage of Guinness, from its humble beginnings to its rise as a global brand enjoyed across the globe. And what better place to savor a pint of Guinness than at the Gravity Bar, perched high above Dublin with stunning views of the city.

After this introduction to Dublin, you'll check into your hotel and enjoy some free time. Spend your first evening soaking in the atmosphere of a city known for having a pub-to-person ratio that's the envy of many other capitals!

Tuesday November 25th: A Day Trip to Wicklow

Enjoy a hearty breakfast this morning and prepare to trade city lights for scenic countryside, as today's tour takes you to County Wicklow—known as "The Garden of Ireland.". You will visit one of Ireland's most famous attractions: the Glendalough Monastic Site. ounded by Saint Kevin in the 6th century, is nestled in a glaciated valley with two serene lakes. Despite enduring Viking attacks over the centuries, Glendalough flourished as one of Ireland's great ecclesiastical centers and schools of learning until the



Normans destroyed the monastery in 1214 A.D. Here, we'll explore the story of Glendalough and tour the grounds of the "Monastic City," which features a number of monastic remains dating from the 10th to 12th centuries.

After a morning well spent in County Wicklow, you'll return to Dublin by the afternoon. You'll be dropped off at your hotel to enjoy the rest of your day at leisure in the city.

Wednesday November 26th: Next Stop...Belfast



Following breakfast this morning, we will depart Dublin to seek new adventures in Belfast, the famous transformed capital of Northern Ireland and host city of the Friendship Four Festival of Hockey. Traveling north from Dublin, you'll arrive in Belfast, a city known equally for being the birthplace of the **Titanic**, its complex and storied history, and its emergence as one of the most exciting destinations in Ireland, the UK, and beyond.

Upon arrival, you'll enjoy a panoramic sightseeing tour of Belfast, exploring its historic and culturally rich neighborhoods. Highlights include the City Centre, the Protestant neighborhood of Shankill Road, the Catholic neighborhood of Falls Road, and more. After the tour, you'll check in at your hotel and have free time to enjoy the rest of your day in Belfast—a city now celebrated for its outstanding variety and quality of food and drink establishments.

Thursday November 27th: Thanksgiving in Belfast

From Belfast, we will journey via the Causeway Coastal Route, often hailed as one of the world's greatest coastal drives, to reach this geological marvel. The Giant's Causeway is renowned both

historically and scientifically for its striking polygonal columns of layered basalt, formed by a volcanic eruption some 60 million years ago. It's the centerpiece of a designated Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and has long captivated visitors with its natural wonder and legendary tales of giants. You'll enjoy a guided tour of this unique site, rich in geological significance and local folklore.

After a memorable day exploring Northern Ireland's natural beauty, we'll return to the hotel to prepare for a special **Thanksgiving Dinner**—a festive evening to reflect, relax, and celebrate in Irish style.
